Go With God's Blessings

*Congregation please stand

In a world filled with distractions, we often lose sight of what truly matters—Christ Himself. In this week's message, we'll explore Jesus' encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well and how He redirects her focus from division, tradition, and worldly concerns to the only thing that truly satisfies: Himself. Too often, like the woman at the well, we major in the minors—arguing about worship styles, theological non-essentials, and religious traditions—while missing the presence of the Savior right in front of us.

Join us as we examine how Jesus calls us away from empty wells that cannot satisfy and offers us the living water of eternal life. Through this passage, we will see the gospel woven like a crimson cord, reminding us that true worship is not about a place, but a Person—Jesus Christ.
